General Business

- Staff reviewed with the Committee PRISM's Program Performance Reports to provide information to committee members with insights into program-level claims performance, emerging loss trends, and historical development patterns.
- The Committee approved binding the SIR to \$10M layer with incumbent carriers, Berkshire Hathaway (55%), and Mitsui Sumitomo Insurance Group (45%), as presented.
- Alliant provided an update on the 2026/27 premium allocation methodology for the GL2 Program. The Committee approved the 2026/27 premium allocation methodology.
- Staff provided an update regarding a claim audit for Tulare County. There were no staff recommendations.
- Staff reviewed with the Committee amendments of the GL2 MOC that was previously proposed in February. The Committee considered the proposed amendments in conjunction with the review and comments that were received. The Committee voted to approve all proposed revisions, with an exception of the SAM endorsement's Exclusion C.2., which was rejected.

- Staff provided an update about the Case Assessment offering with Courtroom Science, Inc., which was previously approved by the Committee at the April 2, 2026 meeting. Staff is working on coming up with the criteria for using the assessments and will bring a recommendation about this to a future CRC2 meeting.
- Staff provided the Committee with an update about the evaluation of AmTrust years. Following prior commutation and member assessments, the program now shows a positive funding balance. No additional assessment is needed at this time.
- The Committee approved the City of Glendora for membership in the GL2 Program, with a retention of \$1M, effective July 1, 2026, subject to carrier approvals.
- The Committee approved the City of Culver City for membership in the GL2 Program, with retention options of \$1M, \$2M, and \$3M, effective July 1, 2026, subject to carrier approvals.
