Legislative Activity

PRISM Lobbyist, Priscilla Quiroz, provided an update on the 2022 legislative session.

The Committee discussed the results of the 2022 legislative session, which marks the end of the two-year bill cycle.

PRISM's Legislative Committee reviewed and actively followed 203 bills this year, in which 57% of these (115 bills) died in Committee and did not make it to the Governor's desk for consideration. The Committee took a Watch position on 149 of the bills, and either an Oppose, Concerns or Support position on 54 bills.

Of the 54 bills that PRISM took a formal position on (e.g. Support, Oppose, Concerns), only 30 bills made it to the Governor's desk. The Governor signed 17 bills that PRISM opposed or expressed concerns and 7 bills that PRISM supported. The Governor vetoed 5 bills that PRISM opposed and 1 bill that PRISM supported.

Staff will be meeting with the lobbying team in early November to establish next steps for items on the legislative action plan.
