**General Business**

- Staff reviewed with the Committee areas that have been identified in the Medical Malpractice Program’s premium allocating/rating methodology where the current structure and rating approach may no longer fully account for the Program’s evolution, market conditions, and underlying risk profile. Staff was seeking philosophical direction from the Committee, so staff can reevaluate and bring potential options back to the Committee at a future meeting.
- The Committee approved transferring the Medical Malpractice Program’s risk for the \$2M corridor retention for the 2026/27 year to PRISM ARC.
- Staff presented the Medical Professional Field Services MOC Endorsement to the Committee, which was originally supposed to be an action item, but the Committee had questions regarding the language around coverage. Staff will work with legal counsel to clarify endorsement language.
- Staff informed the Committee that they will be bringing Medical Malpractice claims handling in-house.
