• **ERC Consultant Selection**

- Staff presented Dar Rhodes' application for the ERC program. The Committee reviewed and approved her addition to the program, pending successful completion of a background check.

• **EAGLE Awards**

- At its January 2027 meeting, the Committee will consider a streamlined EAGLE Award program and submission process presented by staff.
- Staff presented 12 EAGLE Award applications, six of which the Committee approved.

• **Member Services Philosophy**

- Staff presented the philosophy guiding the development of services for PRISM members.
- Staff provided definitions for the commonly used terms services, tools, and resources.

- The Committee asked staff to ensure that the Member Services philosophy and terminology are reflected on the Member Services Committee webpage.
- **Employee Benefits**
 - Staff discussed continued collaboration with Employee Benefits.
 - PRISM Health successfully completed its first renewal as an independent health program.
 - A \$250,000 PRISM Wellness Fund is being distributed to PRISM Health Program members.
 - Two successful symposiums were held this spring, one in Long Beach and one in San Ramon.
 - Thirty health care enrollment events are planned for the coming year.
- **Staff Report**
 - The PRISM Annual Conference will be held September 29–October 2, 2026.
 - Staff will present at this year's conference.
 - PRISM's Cyber Liability Matching Grant Program will launch soon.
 - Beazley's Incident Management System:
 - Will be available to Cyber Program participants on an opt-in/opt-out basis.
 - Will help participants manage incidents when they arise.
 - Will not affect participation in the Cyber Program.
 - An additional de-escalation training has been scheduled for October 13 in San Bernardino.
 - A new POST-certified Report Writing course will be available soon.
 - The October 13, 2026, PRISM Open Forum will address cybersecurity.
 - Beazley will participate in the presentation.
 - Staff is working with Lozano Smith to update the School Liability Handbook and the School Administrators Guide to Preventing Sexual Abuse and Molestation.
