2026 PRISMHealth Program Actuarial Report

Turner Consulting and Actuarial presented the annual actuarial and recommended adjustments for the program's Incurred But Not Reported (IBNR) and Claims Fluctuation Margin (CFM) reserves. The Committee voted to approve the recommended funding levels: IBNR \$85.2M and CFM \$35.7M. The Committee also reviewed the Cash Flow funding estimate that illustrates how the funding structure supports the accumulation of the IBNR and CFM over time.

2027 PRISMHealth Program Fixed Administrative Costs

The Committee approved the fixed administrative costs for the 2027 PRISMHealth Program renewal, effective January 1, 2027. The estimated pooled expense for the 2027 plan year is 4.9% of premium.

2027 PRISMHealth Program Renewal

Alliant presented the 2027 pool renewal and member specific CPRA adjustments for the PRISMHealth Program. The Committee voted to decline the 2027 renewal as presented and instructed staff and Alliant to return with options that could result in a reduction to the proposed 15.96% increase. Requested renewal options included the exclusion of GLP-1 coverage for weight loss and additional review of the proposed 1.8% margin meant to further fund reserves.

Digbi Health - Service Change Recommendation

Due to the possible changes to GLP-1 coverage in the 2027 PRISMHealth Program renewal, which could affect the necessity of this item, the Committee voted to continue the item to the next meeting.

Carrum Health – Substance Use Disorder Services

The Committee approved expanding Carrum Health services to include Carrum's newly implemented Substance Use Disorder treatment program, effective July 1, 2026.

New Member Applications

The Committee approved the following agencies for membership in the PRISMHealth Program, large member segment:

- Livermore Area Recreation and Park District effective February 1, 2027
- Monterey-Salinas Transit effective January 1, 2027

Other Matters

Staff informed the Committee that the deadline to comply with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) has been extended until April of 2027, and clarified that the majority of PRISM's carriers were either at or exceeded requirements.
