Program Performance Report (PPR)

Staff presented the PPR, updated through June 30, 2021. Premium volume for all combined program segments is \$299M, with medical/pharmacy claims and fixed costs totaling \$285M, resulting in a program funding ratio of 95%.

New Member Application

The Committee reviewed and approved Merced Irrigation District for entry into the PRISMHealth Program, large member segment, effective January 1, 2022.

2022 Express Scripts (ESI) Formulary Update

The January 1, 2022 ESI formulary update was presented with 0.89% disruption to PRISMHealth plan participants.

2022 Legislative and Regulatory Updates

The Committee approved optional Blue Shield contract updates to include: up to a 90-day supply of prescription maintenance drugs from a retail pharmacy, and the High Deductible Health Plan to include peak flow meters and glucose monitors and allow them to be covered prior to deductible being met.

Alliant Program Updates

Alliant updated the Committee on the status of the following:

- Third Party Administration RFI and RFP – Open market review for traditional TPA services is expected to be evaluated and presented by early 2022, with an effective date of January 1, 2023.
- Livongo Diabetes Services – Implementation and communication strategy are on schedule for the January 1, 2022 effective date.
- Carrum 2022 Program Enhancement – Oncology services available are being evaluated along with ROI. This service will not be recommended for January 1, 2022, but will be considered once Carrum Health is able to confirm contracting with The Hope Institute.
- COVID-19 Action Plan and Employer Vaccine Mandate – Alliant noted that this initiative is under review for impact to the program members and the overall program claims experience.

Carrum Health Program Enhancement – Hinge Health

The Committee approved the addition of the Carrum Health Program Enhancement - Hinge Health musculoskeletal services, for all applicable PRISMHealth Program members, effective January 1, 2022.

Staff Report

- Staff reported the withdrawal of San Benito County from the Program, as well as Tuolumne County joining the Program, both effective January 1, 2022.
- Staff also reported that planning for the 2022 Healthcare Symposium has begun, currently scheduled for March 31st in Sacramento, and April 7th in Long Beach, with plans for these to be in person events.
