Insurance Programs

- A GL1 MOC change for out-of-state participant, WSRMP, was approved to include Stop Gap Employers Liability coverage to their members;
- The EWC 2024/25 payroll audit results were received by the Committee;
- Staff provided an update on the 2026/27 renewal application process, along with the status of the monthly loss data collection;
- The Committee recommended to the Executive Committee and Board of Directors to approve modifying the EWC & GL1 minimum premiums, as follows:
 - Members with SIRs less than \$300k: \$15k for EWC and \$25k for GL1
 - Members with SIRs between \$300k and \$1M: \$10k for EWC and \$15k for GL1
 - Members with SIRs at and over \$1M: \$5k for EWC and \$10k for GL1
- EWC – The Committee approved LAWCX’s request to add the PLAN JPA as an additional named covered party;
- GL1 – The Committee received an update on the 2025/26 renewal, including the Pool Buy-Down;
- GL1 – The Committee approved an out-of-state participant’s request, OSIG, for limit increases for 2 of their school members;
- GL1 – The Committee approved the City of El Segundo for membership in the GL1 Program, effective July 1, 2026;
- GL1 – The Committee reviewed Napa County’s request for a dam coverage buyback for their Lake Marie Dam. The Committee had concerns regarding the dam’s inspection results, the items noted for correction or repair, and the runoff

exposure. The Committee directed staff to work with the County to obtain this information, and to bring it back to the next meeting for consideration.

The Committee approved the 2026 Calendar of Meetings.
