Dear Member,

The Master Crime Program is currently written with a Primary Policy of \$10 Million limits and an Excess Policy of \$5 Million limits excess \$10 Million limits. The full and complete copies of the 2020/2021 Master Crime Primary Policy and Master Crime Excess Policy are available in the My Entity Documents area of PRISM's website. Also available online are template letters to the judge and signature pages. This letter is being sent as a reminder to all the Program's County members to file this Policy as required by California Government Code.

California Government Code (GC) section 1458 requires that certain county officers post official bonds. GC 1481 allows for a master bond, in lieu of individual bonds; additionally, GC1463 allows for crime insurance in lieu of a bond.

Based on the aforementioned Government Code, the PRISM Master Crime Policy can be used to fulfill the bonding requirements for many public officials.

California Government Code Sections 1457 and 1459 address the counties' obligation to have the Policy approved by the presiding superior court judge, and then recorded with the county recorder, filed with the county clerk, and also filed with the county treasurer (as respects the county clerk's coverage).
